

GEF'S 30 UNDER 30 ENTRY GUIDELINES



If you'd like to join us in shouting about the island's community under 30, please do submit your Gef's 30 Under 30 nomination in good time before nominations close Monday 17 March at 11:59pm.

We recommend reading and sharing these Entry Guidelines before submitting your application, which needs to be completed online in a single sitting. Applications cannot be updated once they have been submitted.

We recommend sharing this PDF with anyone you're nominating or encouraging to nominate.

Requirements:

- Provide answers to the below questions online via the 30 Under 30 [website](#).
- Upload a nominee photo - this is mainly for administrative purposes, but may be used publicly in the 30 Under 30 winners announcement.
- The person you're nominating must be aware of the nomination and have consented to you sharing their details and story.
- Previous 30 Under 30 winners can be nominated again, however they'll only be able to win in a different category to the one they previously won.

It's important to include information about you or your nominee's achievements and impact in their career or workplace, as well as the wider island community or economy. Provide our judging panel with as much information as possible about why you or your nominee are an exceptional young person on the Isle of Man.

30 winners will be announced in April, and the Winners' Party will take place in mid-May. Please note that winners will need to attend a winners photo and video shoot over the Easter holidays. Details of this will be shared with winners announcements.
